

DURING READING

Begin reading the story aloud to the class. Pause after you read,

“Are you going to sneeze?”
said his mother.

aah- aaah- Aaaah-

so students can predict the next page. (Students will likely shout out “Chu!”)



Pause after you read,

“Are you going to sneeze?”
asked his father.
AAH- AAAAH- AAAAAH-

so students can again predict what happens next. Point out that the words
AAH-AAAAH-AAAAAH- are written in all capital letters and ask students why.



Pause after you read:

I will tell you something,
said Chu.

Guess what? said Chu.

Ask students what they think Chu is going to say.



Aaachooooooooooooo!

Pause after you read:

I think I am going to sneeze,
said Chu.

Ask students what they think is going to happen,
and ask them to read the next page aloud with you:



Go back through the book and show each two-page spread slowly and have students
share all the details they notice in the illustrations. (Students can “pair share” with a partner.)

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
